

# CONFLICT TRANSFORMATION AND RESILIENCE, GRADUATE MICROCREDENTIAL

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The microcredential in conflict transformation and resilience deepens students' understanding of the causes and catalysts of conflict. It provides skill-based development around opportunities to transform conflict into constructive opportunities for collaboration and innovation. Skills include negotiation, conflict mediation, interpersonal and personal peacemaking, restorative practice frameworks and restorative justice tools.

## Admission Requirements

### Application Deadlines

### Admission

The program is open to current UWM students in degree or certificate programs and non-degree or special students enrolling at UWM solely for a credit-bearing microcredential.

UWM students already enrolled in another degree or certificate (such as minimum UWM GPA) – minimum 2.75 GPA in Bachelor's degree from an accredited institution required. Non-degree or special students enrolling in credit-bearing micro credentials (such as prior educational attainment, prior GPA) – minimum 2.75 GPA in Bachelor's degree from an accredited institution required.
